

this cause, and APP was born. These young volunteers have since undertaken a number of projects in Africa that have made a significant impact to restoring dignity and improving the conditions for prisoners.

Building on this momentum, in 2007 APP was incorporated as a charitable company. Later that year they received registered charity status in the UK. From 2008, APP has set up a permanent base in Kampala, Uganda as their African headquarters to enable them to plan for the future.

TRIP INFORMATION:



The Chaplaincy volunteers will live with and work alongside Revd Canon Fred Komunda, the only Church of Uganda Chaplain to Uganda Prisons. Revd Komunda is based at Luzira Prisons Complex on the edge of Kampala, a complex which consists of 5 prison units. The volunteers will support Revd Fred with conducting services and bible studies, but more broadly in offering a wide range of spiritual and rehabilitative support to inmates and staff, including offering counselling, Alpha courses, peace building courses and assistance to ex inmates during the crucial few days immediately after their release from detention.

Each volunteer will be expected to commit to being in Uganda for at least 2 months, but preferably for a longer period of up to two years. They will pay £400 each per month which will contribute towards their

food and accommodation and a contribution towards the projects they are working on. Up to two chaplaincy volunteers can be accommodated at one time.

Requirements: The volunteer should have an interest in spiritual work, religious tolerance, patience, empathy, self confidence, self motivation and excellent communication skills. They should be prepared to live in comfortable, but basic accommodation.

*COST & FURTHER INFORMATION

The cost (excluding flights, visa and immunisations) will be from £1250 for 2 months, £1800 for 3 months and £2500 for 4 months.
